## YMCA Camp Campbell Gard – Criteria of Service

YMCA Camp Campbell Gard's programs for campers with developmental disabilities are designed for individuals with a mild to moderate intellectual or physical disability. Our program is for individuals ages 7–22\*. The individual must still be in school to be eligible for enrollment.

We strive to provide a safe, enriching, and fun environment for all of our campers. Unfortunately we are unable to serve participants who demonstrate one or more of the following:

- Participants who require any 1:1 support
- Participants who require assistance in their daily routine such as eating and toileting care. Participants must be able to perform personal care tasks independently or with verbal prompting
- Flight risk off camp property
- Safety risk/flight risk towards open bodies of water and roads
- Significant property destruction
- Extreme aggression towards self or others
- Inappropriate behavior directed toward others (sexual, discriminatory, etc.)
- Consistent refusal to participate in group activities and programming

YMCA Camp Campbell Gard assesses individual eligibility through an application and interview process.

Safety is our ultimate goal; YMCA Camp Campbell Gard reserves the right to dismiss an individual from the program if the participant becomes a safety risk to themselves or others.
